
Using a wash-away pen, make horizontal line across the middle of the area.




Select the ruler that quilts a circle 1" in diameter. (You'll be quilting around the inside of a circle whose opening in 1-1/2".) Tape together a few nested rulers if desired to give yourself more surface area. Starting on the left edge of the area and aligning quadrant markings on the ruler with the marked line you made in step 1, quilt a clockwise circle.



Continue to quilt on top of your previous stitches until you get to the right side of the circle.



Move the ruler and quilt another circle, stitching in a counter-clockwise direction. Continue to quilt on top of your previous stitches until you get to the right side of the circle.



Quilt one more circle to complete this motif.
