




SUPPLIES: MAKES SIX EGGS

- Two IO" squares of fabric, tone on tone fabrics are a good choice
- Two 10" squares of Fusi-Bond Lite adhesive web SLG1011 from Lazy Girl
- One 10" square of Stiff Stuff firm sew-in interfacing SLG107SQ from Lazy Girl
- One 10" square of Face-It Soft lightweight woven fusible interfacing SLG 1031 from Lazy Gırl
- Egg template Coordinating thread, I used Aurifil 40wt thread
- Erasable marking tool, I used a heat-erasable marker
- Sewing machine needle size 70/10 or 80/20, I use SCHMETZ Chrome Professional Grade
