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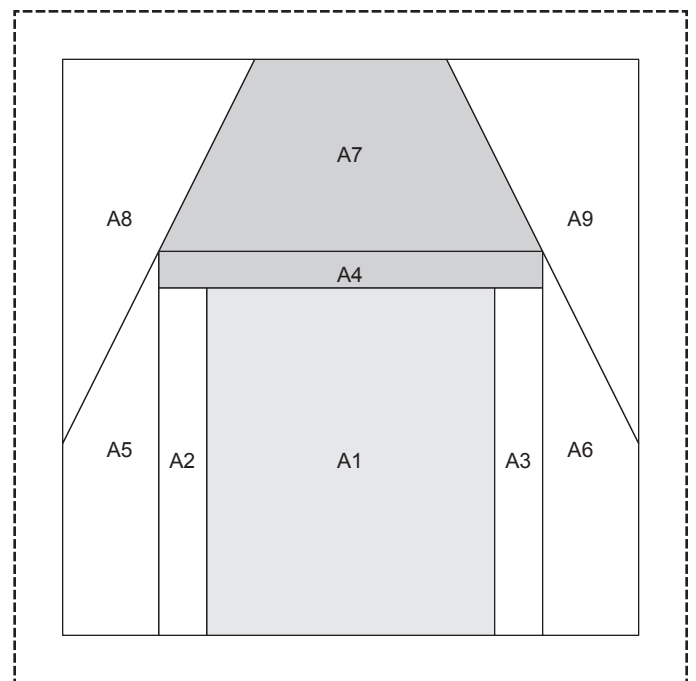
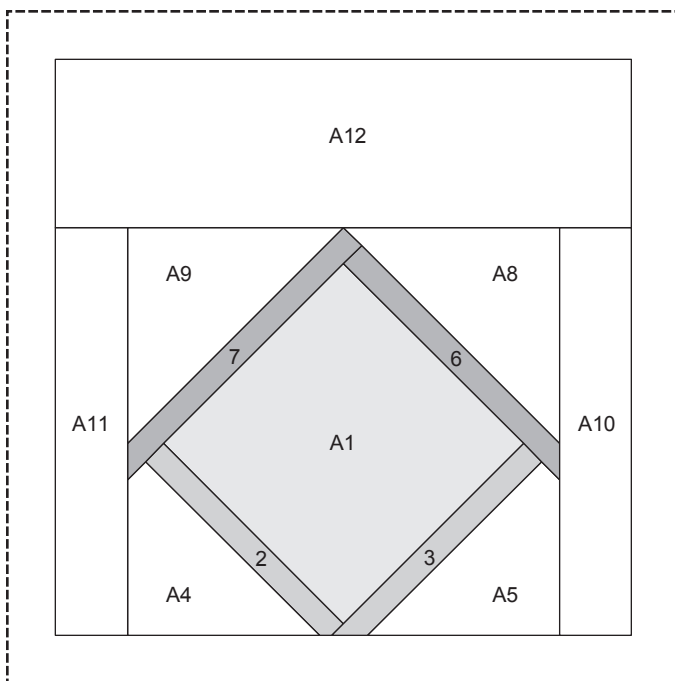
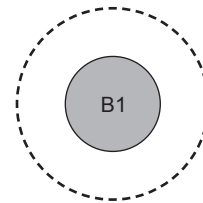
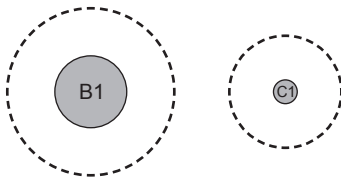
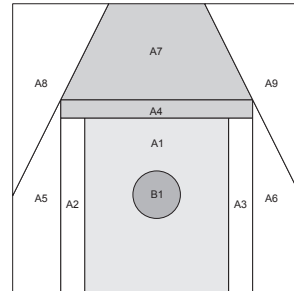
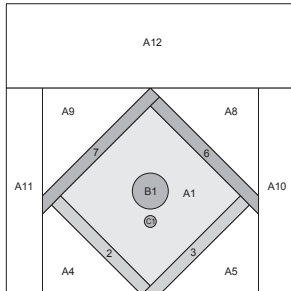
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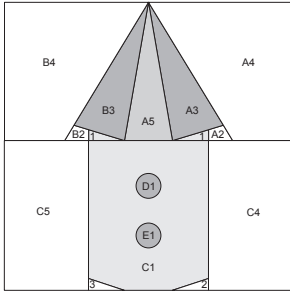
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Birdhouse Mini Blocks – Birdhouses (A & B)

Before beginning, be sure to measure the 1” mark on pattern pages to ensure pattern was printed at full size. Sew each block or section individually. Press and trim each section prior to sewing sections together. See the quilt map for assembly assistance and the colored quilt for help distinguishing the shades of grey. Please read through all of the instructions, tips and tricks, and the accompanying tutorial on WeAllSew.com before beginning.



Birdhouse Mini Blocks – Birdhouses (C & D)

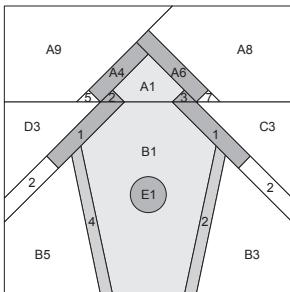
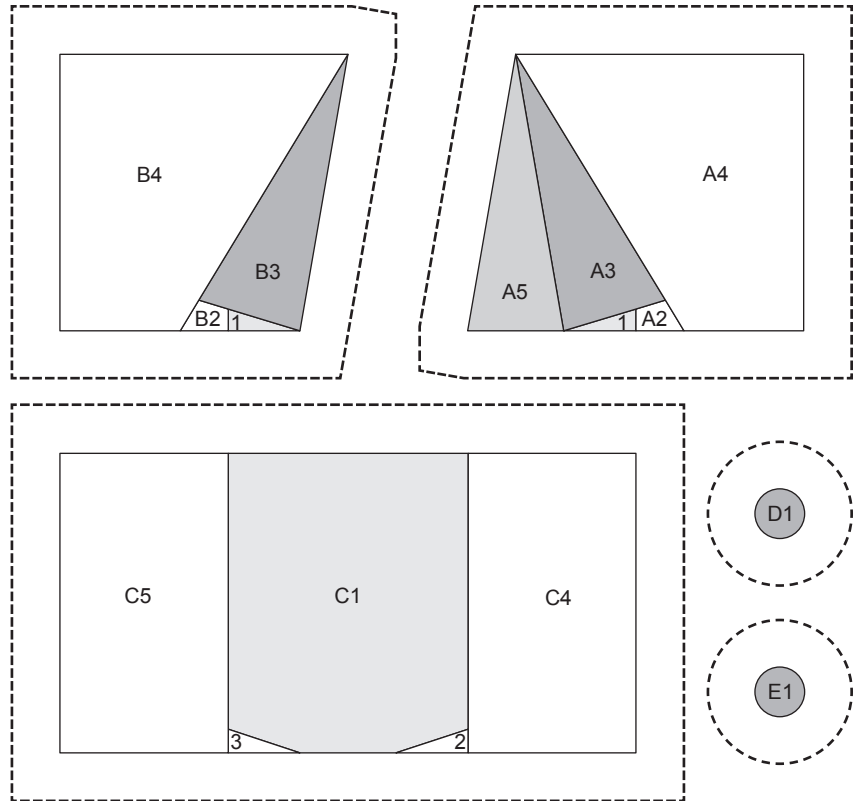


Block C Assembly

Sew A to B

Sew A/B to C to finish.

Press blocks when finished prior to trimming. Do not remove papers until the entire quilt top is finished.



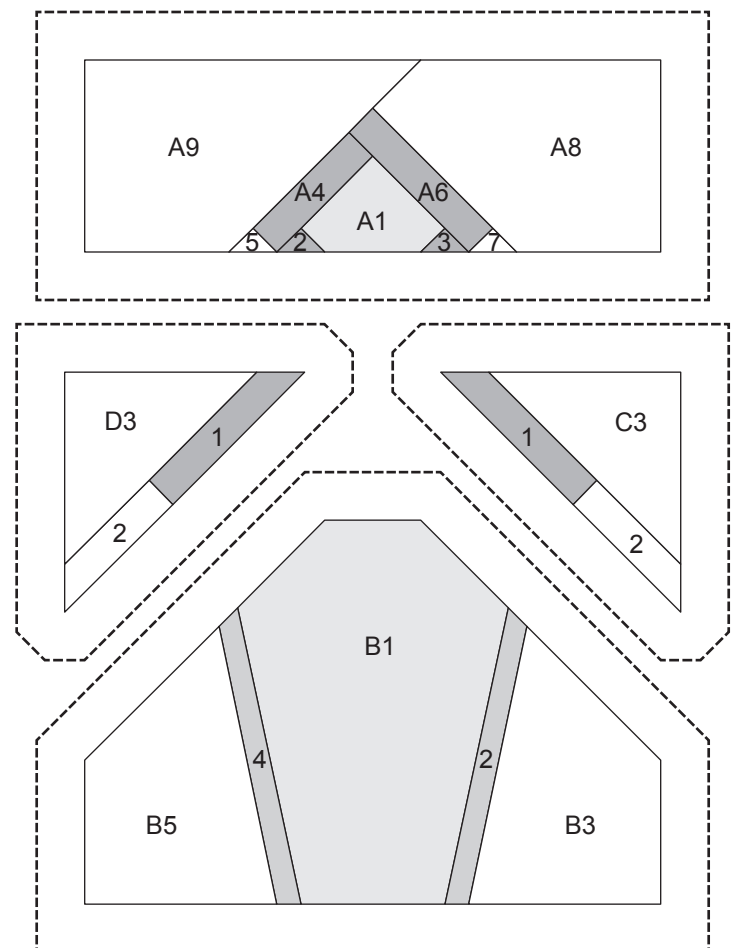
Block D Assembly

Sew C to the corner of B

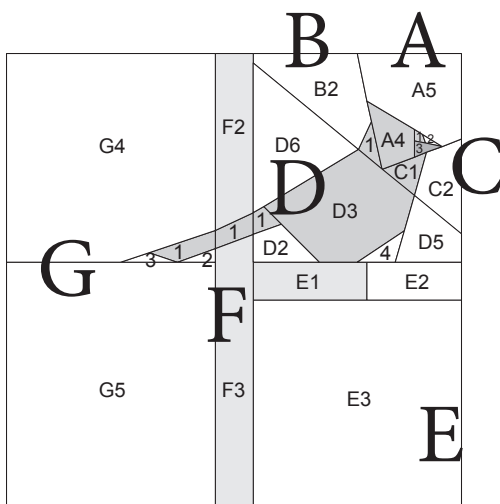
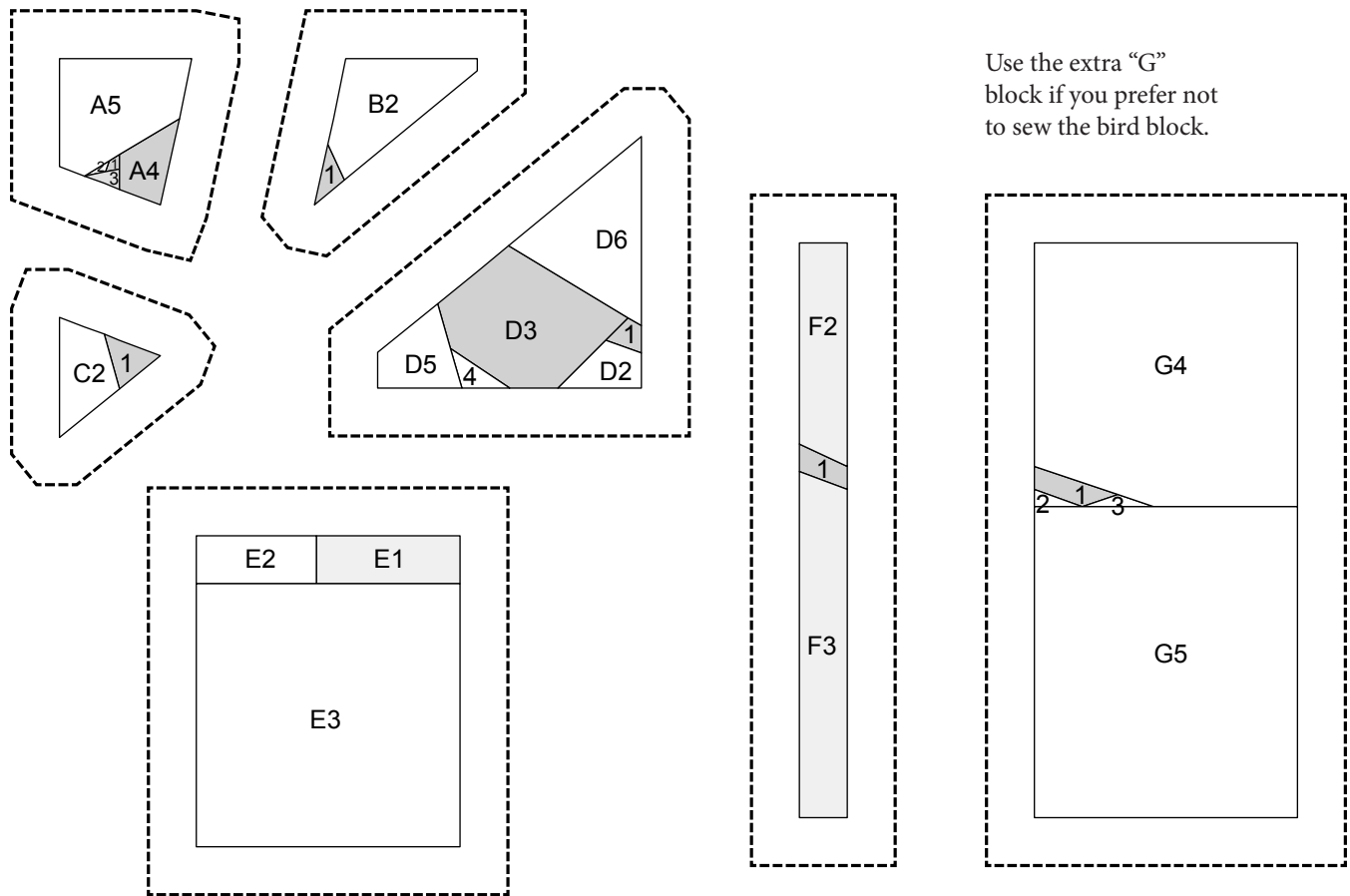
Sew D to the corner of B/C

Sew A to the top of B/C/D to finish.

Press blocks when finished prior to trimming. Do not remove papers until the entire quilt top is finished.



Birdhouse Mini Block – Bird (E)



Bird Block Assembly

Sew B to the top corner of A
Sew C to the bottom corner of A/B
Sew A/B/C to D :: Sew A/B/C/D to the top of E

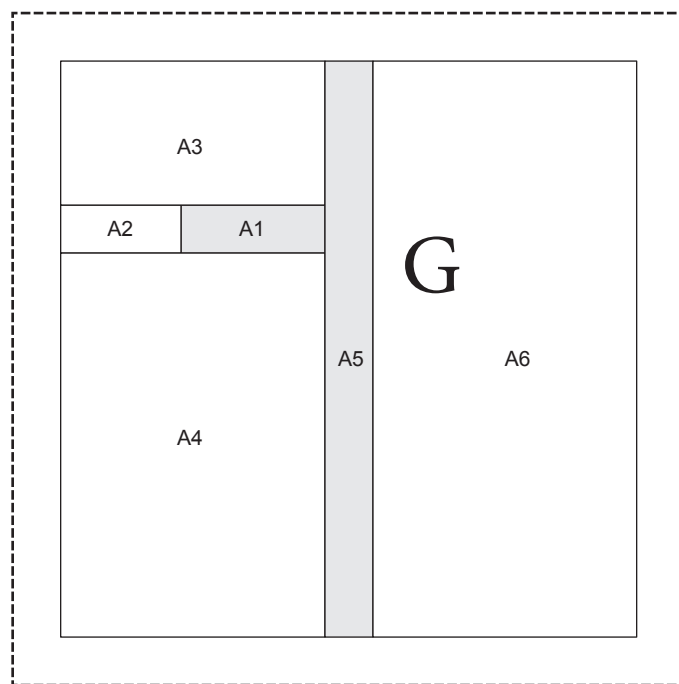
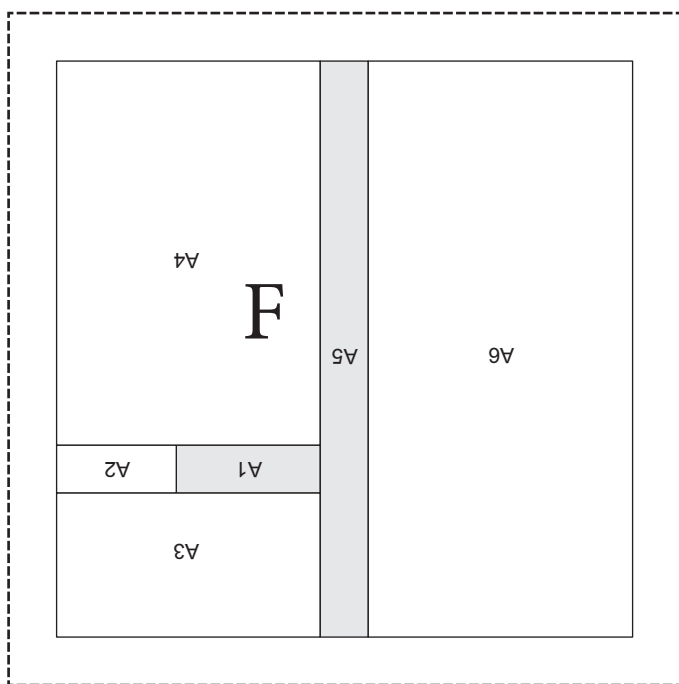
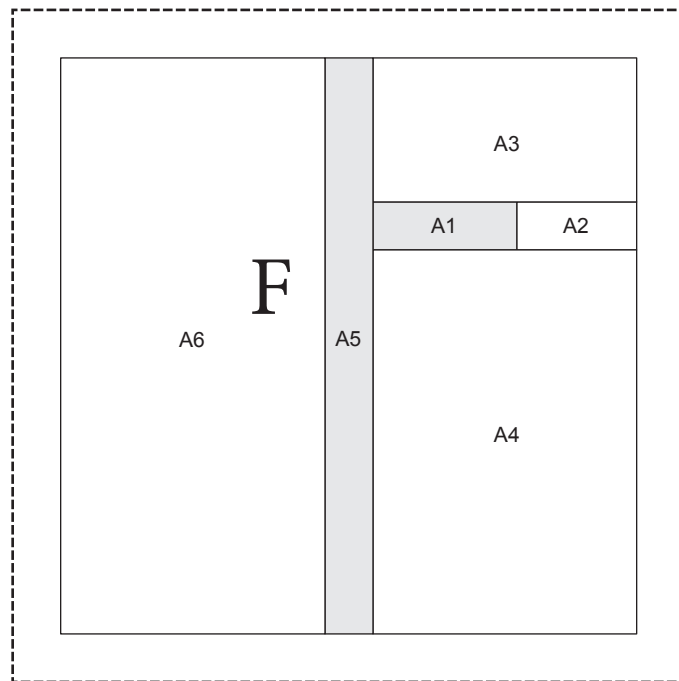
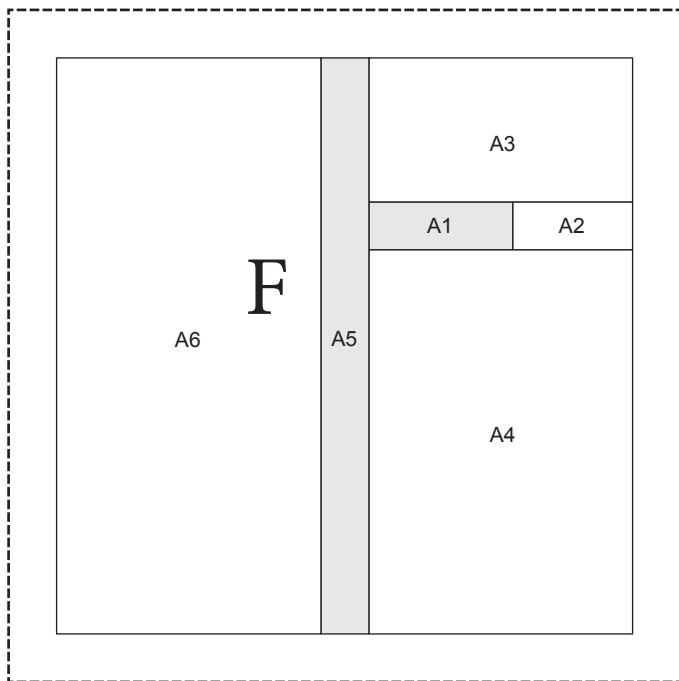
Sew F to G :: Sew A/B/C/D/E to F/G to finish.

Press blocks when finished prior to trimming. Do not remove papers until the entire quilt top is finished.

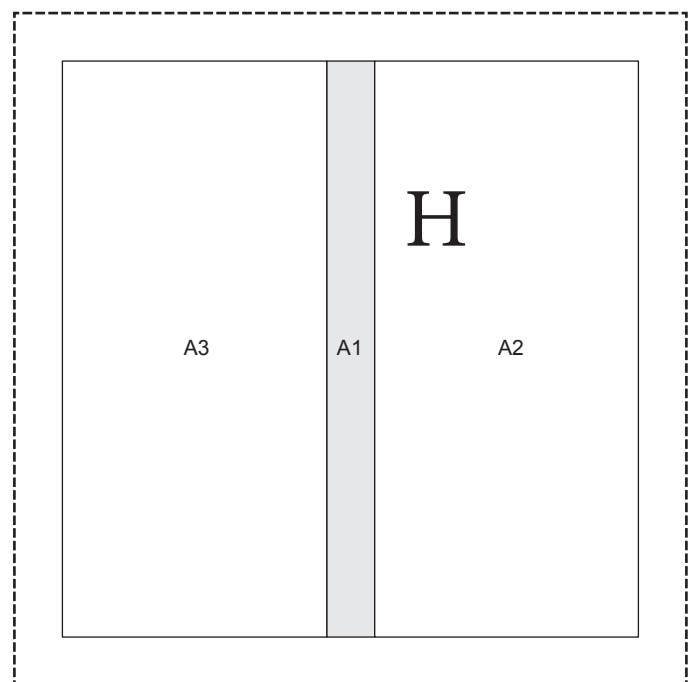
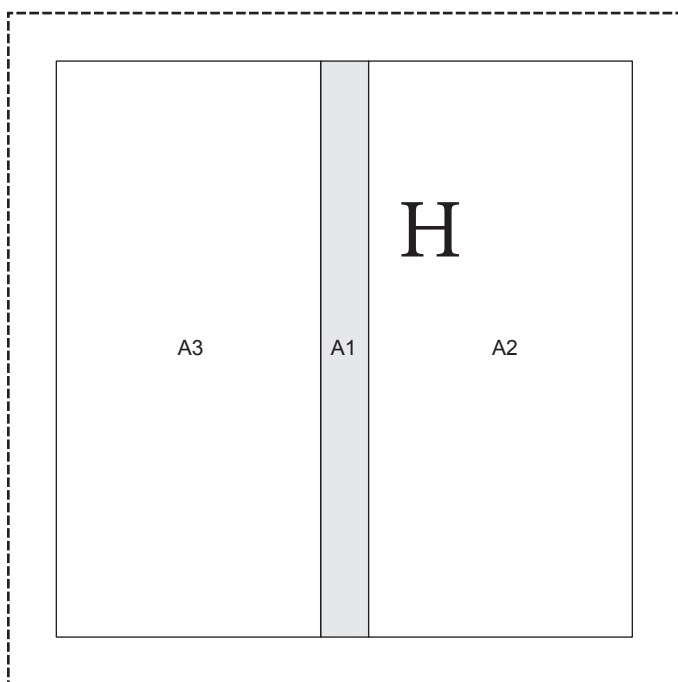
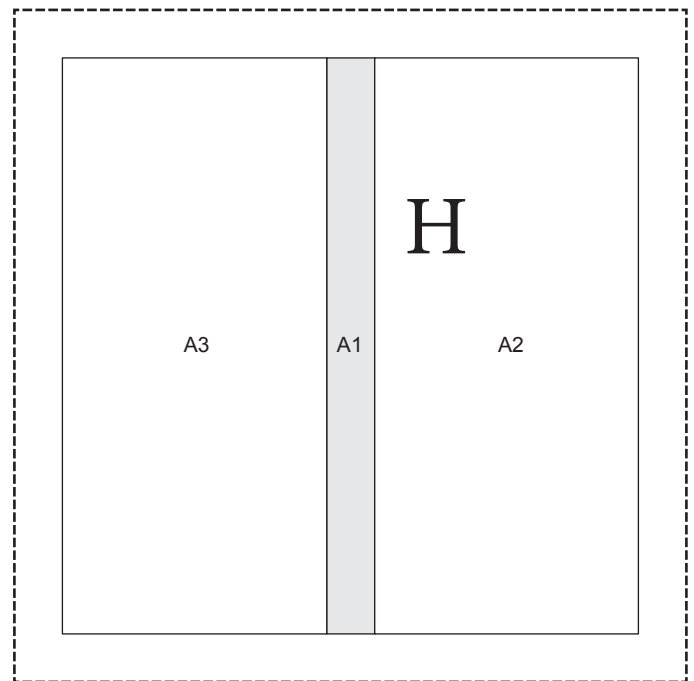
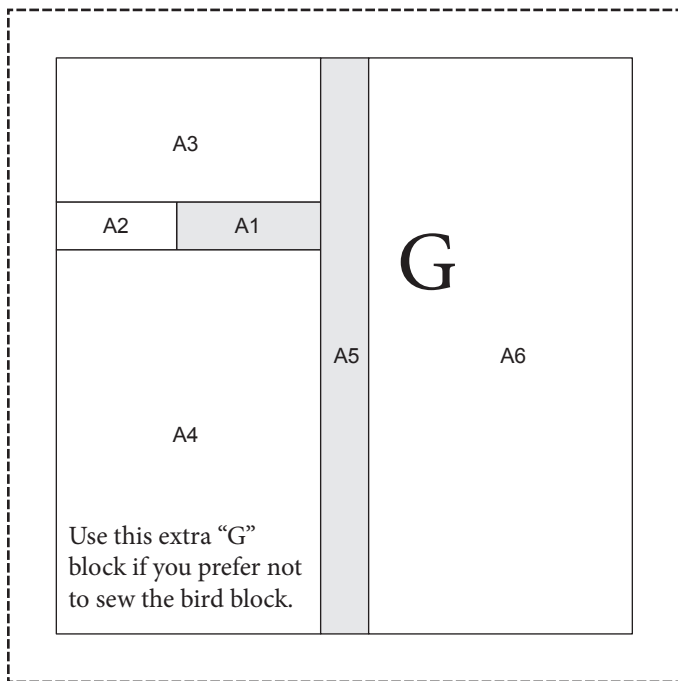
*If you do not want to sew the bird block, sew an extra “G” block.

"T" blocks are 3 1/2" and can be cut using a rotary cutter or using one of the H blocks as a template.



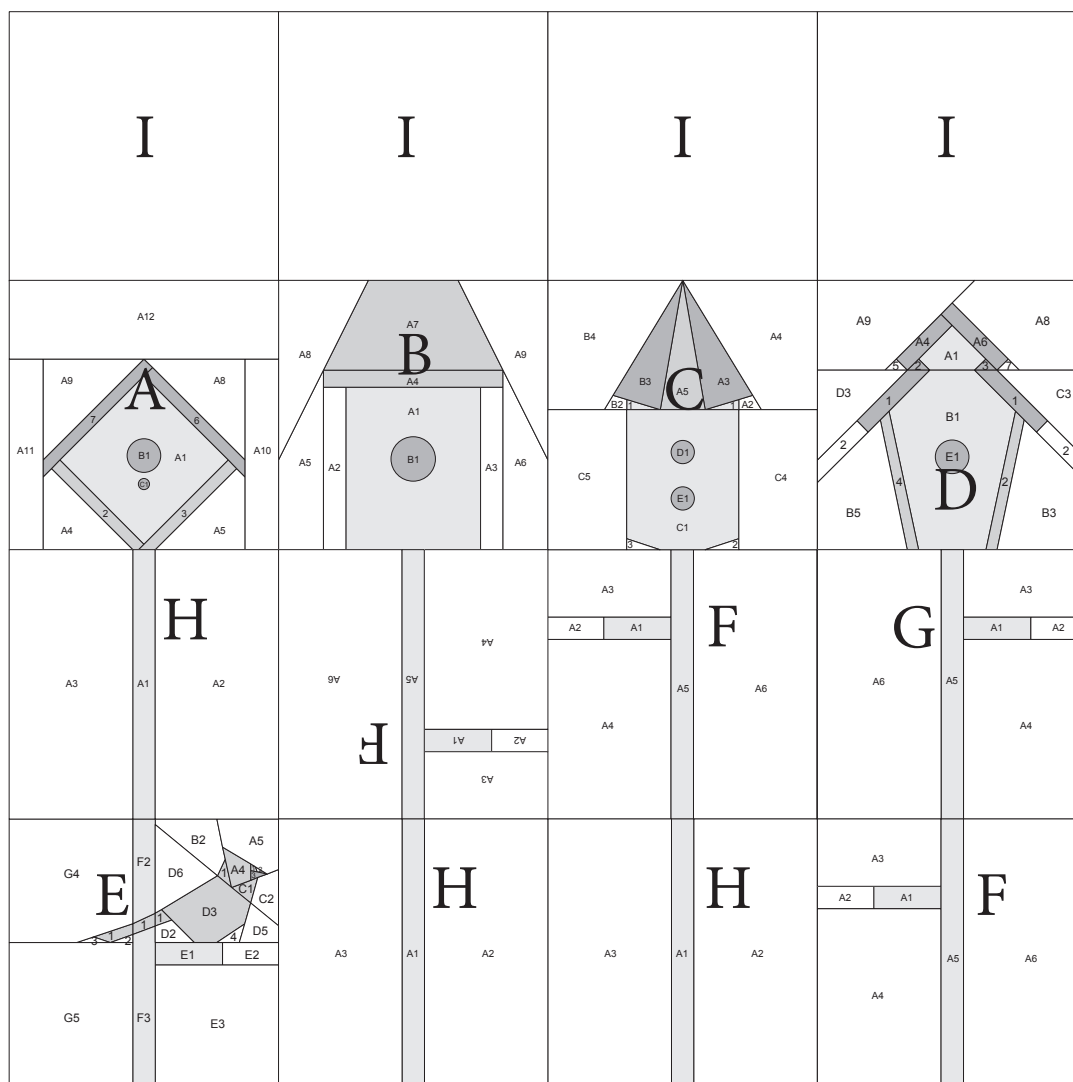
Finishing the Birdhouse Mini Quilt Tips

Leave all paper pieces attached in the blocks until quilt top is completed. If you have removed the paper already, glue basting can help prevent stretching of individual pieces that have been sewn on the bias to otherwise prevent the distortion of the fabrics.

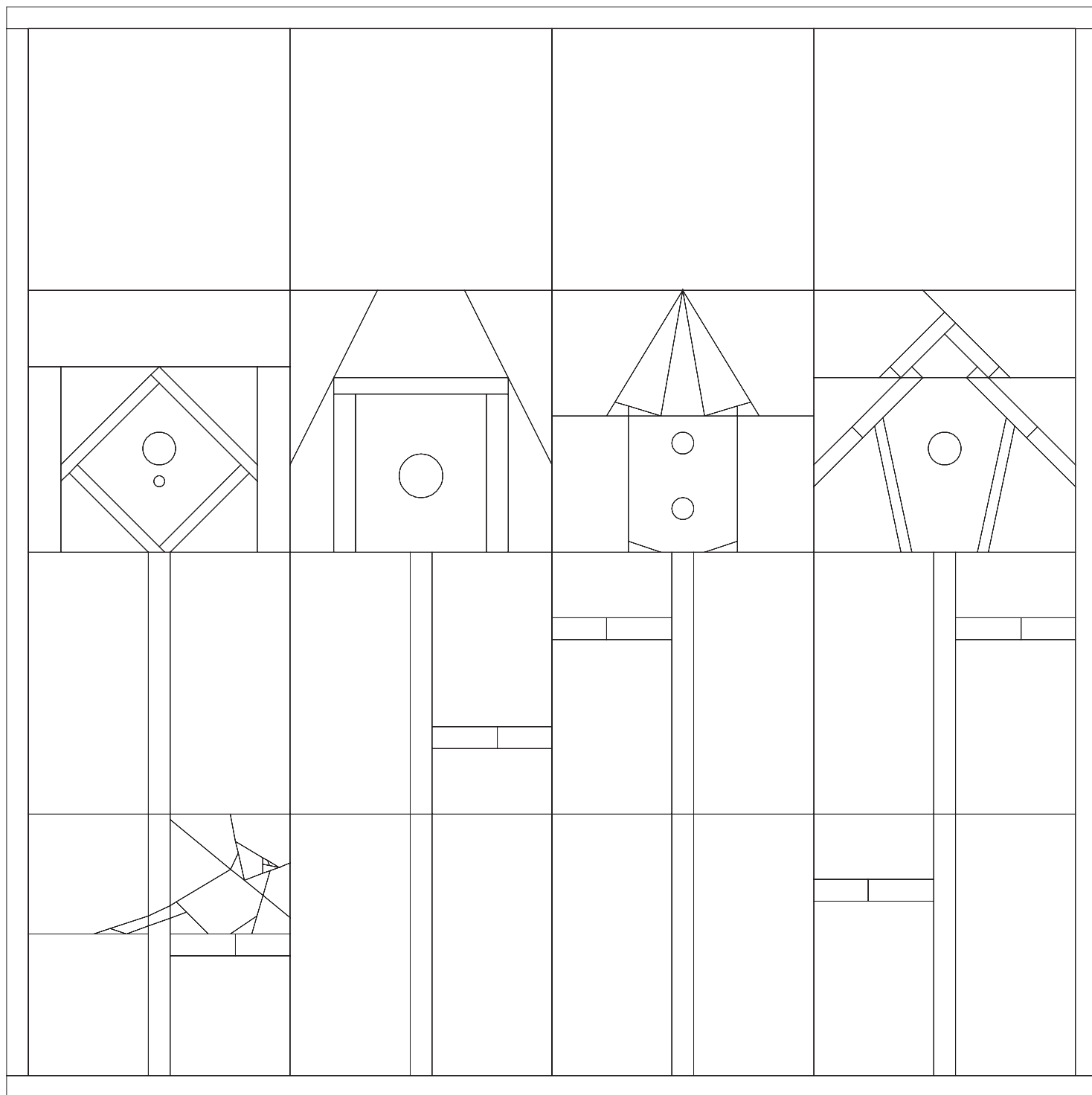
Quilt Assembly

1. Sew all of the blocks together using the Map below as the guide. If using directional prints, note that one of the "F" blocks should be sewn so it can be placed upside down. Cut four "I" blocks to sew along the top.
2. Carefully remove paper pieces from each block. Use tweezers to get tiny pieces out of seam allowances.
3. Press quilt top from both sides, first from the back to press seams checking for any missed seam trimmings.
4. Layer quilt top, batting and quilt backing, and quilt as desired.
5. Square up and trim quilt edges.
6. Cut binding to 2 1/2" wide. Sew strips together on the bias to have approx. 60" of binding (12" extra to have room to connect the ends).
7. Fold binding as single or double fold and sew binding to quilt as preferred to finish.
