
Part 3: Blocks 3 & 4 and Free-Motion Options



Block 3

Bring up your bobbin thread in the center of the design. Bring your foot and needle down and snug the 3" Every Circle ruler up against the edge of the foot, lining up the midline on the ruler over one of "spokes" as shown.


Quilt all the way around the ruler, repositioning your hands several times so that you keep control and the ruler doesn't slip. Return to the center of the design.



Quilt a circle on JUST the horizontal and vertical "spokes", returning to the center each time.




Part 3: Blocks 3 & 4 and Free-Motion Options



Change thread colors if desired.

Using the 12" side of the Every Curve ruler and aligning it as shown, quilt petals on the diagonal spokes, in the same manner you did for Block 2.

If you don't have my Every Curve set, you can achieve a similar look but marking a crosshatch mark 6-1/2" from the center of the block on each of the diagonal "spokes". Then use a curved ruler to connect the center to these marks. If you don't have a big enough ruler to span this distance, adjust your marks accordingly.




Change thread colors if desired.

Using the 8" side of the Every Curve as shown, disregarding its lines, connect the outer center edge of the circles with the outer points of the petals. End your threads.



Block 4

Bring up your bobbin thread in the center of the design IN THE CENTER OF THE 2-1/2" x 5" Oval Ruler from my Ever Oval Ruler set. Bring your foot and needle down and snug the ruler up against the edge of the foot, lining up the vertical midline on the ruler over one of "spokes" as shown.

Quilt all the way around the ruler, repositioning your hands several times so that you keep control and the ruler doesn't slip. Return to the center of the design.




Quilt an oval on each "spoke", returning to the center each time.



Part 3: Blocks 3 & 4 and Free-Motion Options





Change thread colors if desired.

Use a 5" circle ruler to connect the outer center edges of the ovals as shown. (The centers lie on the marked lines.)



Switch to thread that matches the background of the blocks. Free-motion behind the blossom motifs if desired. Free motion in the border to finish the piece.

Finishing

Join the 2-1/4" binding strips into 1 continuous piece. Join binding to the front of the quilt. Fold over and hand-stitch to the back to secure.
