

JUMP FOR JOY QUILT ALONG

Jump For Joy is a delightful quilt that brings a fun element showing off your patchwork and raw-edge fusible applique skills. The sky is the limit to you expressing your creativity while quilting. This Quilt Along is a skill builder from piecing, applique to various free-motion quilting techniques and will be published monthly on the WeAllSew blog.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

Center Row



1. Select **three Chain** and **two Heart & Flower Applique Blocks**.
2. Alternately stitch together to make a **Center Row**; press.

Heart Chain Row



1. Select **three Diamond Heart Units** and **two Partial Chain Blocks**.
2. Alternately arrange and stitch together to make **one Heart Chain Row**; press.
3. Repeat to make a second row.

Flower Row



1. Arrange and join ten **Flower Blocks** to make one **Flower Row**; press.
2. Repeat to make a second row.

Diamond Block Row



1. Join ten **Diamond Blocks** to make one row; press.
2. Repeat to make a second Diamond Block Row.

Side Sashing Row



1. Join two **O strips**, two **I squares** and one **K strip** to make a **Side Sashing Row** as shown; press seams toward **I squares**.
2. Repeat to make a second Side Sashing Row.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY



1. Referring to the Assembly Diagram above, arrange and join **P, Q and R strips** with the **Center Row, Heart Chain Rows, Flower Rows** and **Diamond Block Rows**. Press seams open.
2. Join **Side Sashing Rows** on each side of quilt top center, paying attention to align **I squares** to continue the chain pattern; press.
