## Half - Square Triangles

Gather all **HST** squares reserved for HST piecing and pair each **BG Fabric** square with (1) **Fabric 5** square. From each pair, draw two diagonal lines across the wrong side of the lighter square, then use the instructions below to make 8-at-a-time HSTs.



### HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE INSTRUCTIONS

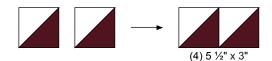


- 1. Place the square with diagonal lines RST with its corresponding square.
- 2. Sew a ¼" seam on each side of the diagonal lines.
- 3. Cut along the the diagonal lines, then cut each of the (4) new units in half to create (8) HSTs.
- 4. Open and press towards the darker fabric.
- 5. Trim all **HSTs** to 3" x 3".
- 6. Repeat steps 1-5 to make a total of (16) 3" x 3" HSTs.

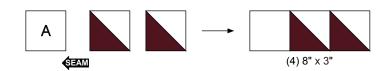


### PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Divide all HSTs into (2) sets of 8. Sew the HSTs from one pile RST into pairs in the arrangement shown at the right. Make (4) 5 1/2" x 3" units.

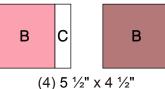


2. Sew the HSTs from the other pile RST into pairs in the arrangement shown at the right. Then, sew A RST to the left of the unit. Repeat to make (4) 8" x 3" units. Press seams toward A.

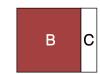


3. Gather all Fabric 1, 2, 3, and 4 B squares, along with all C rectangles. Sew the C rectangles RST to the right side of each B square to make (4) 5 1/2" x 4 1/2" units. Press seams toward all C.

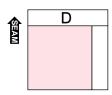




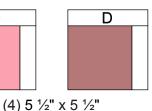




4. Sew (1) D rectangle RST to the top of each unit from step 3 to make (4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" units. Press seams toward all **D**.

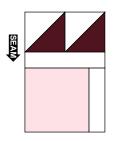


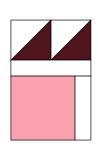


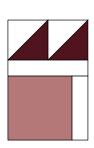


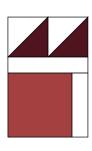


5. Sew the (4) HST units from step 1 RST to the top of each unit from step 4 to make (4) 5 ½" x 8" units. Press seams away from the HST units.



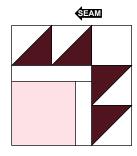


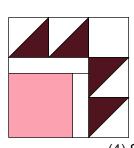


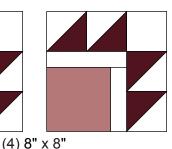


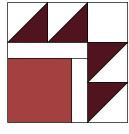

6. Sew the (4) HST units from step 2 RST to the right side of each unit from step 5 to make (4) 8" x 8" units. Press seams away from the HST units.









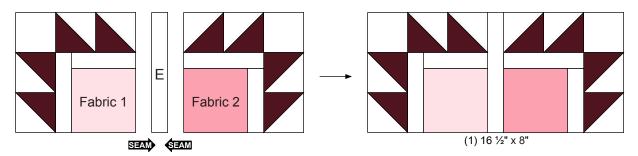
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### **PIECING INSTRUCTIONS**

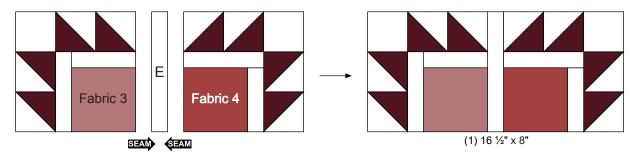
7. Sew (2) **E** RST to the left and right side of **F** to make (1) 16 ½" x 1 ½" unit. Press seams away from **F**.



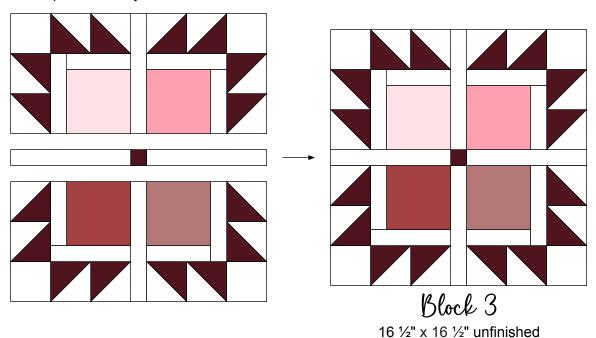
8. Sew the **Fabric 1** unit from step 6 RST to the left side of **E**, then sew the **Fabric 2** unit from step 6 RST to the right side of the unit to make (1) 16 ½" x 8" unit. Press seams toward **E**.



9. Sew the **Fabric 3** unit from step 6 RST to the left side of the last remaining **E**, then sew the **Fabric 4** unit from step 6 RST to the right side of the unit to make (1) 16 ½" x 8" unit. Press seams toward **E**.



10. Sew the unit from step 8 RST to the top of the unit from step 7. Then, take the unit from step 9 and rotate it 180 degrees before sewing it RST to the bottom of the unit to complete the 16 ½" x 16 ½" block. Reserve the block for quilt assembly instructions.
