

Hi There.

Courthouse Steps is a classic block with roots in the traditional Log Cabin, and named for the symmetrical steps leading up to a courthouse. It's built by adding strips outward from a center square, and it's great for practicing precision and rhythm in your piecing. Accurate ½" seams are key here, as a little variation adds up fast when working with narrow strips, so take your time and double-check that seam allowance as you go.



Cutting list/Piece Count Unfinished Size: 16 ½" x 16 ½"



FABRIC #	PIECE COUNT	
1	C - (2) 2" x 4 ½" J - (2) 2" x 16 ½"	
2	D - (2) 2" x 7 ½" I - (2) 2" x 13 ½"	
3	E - (2) 2" x 7 ½" H - (2) 2" x 13 ½"	
4	F - (2) 2" x 10 ½"	
5	FG 2 - (4) 2" x 2" A - (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" G - (2) 2" x 10 ½"	
Background	FG 1 - (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" B - (4) 1 ½" x 1 ½"	BERNINA made to create




Gather (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" BG Fabric FG 1 square and (4) 2" x 2" Fabric 5 FG 2 squares.

Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (4) smaller squares and use the instructions below to make 4-at-a-time FGs.



FLYING GEESE INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Place (2) smaller squares RST in opposite corners on its corresponding FG square. The small squares will overlap in the center.
- 2. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of the diagonal line.
- 3. Cut along the line and separate the unit into (2) parts.
- 4. Open and press seams toward the small triangles.
- 5. Place (2) more smaller squares RST on the (2) new units from previous step (diagram above only shows (1) unit).
- 6. Sew a ¼" seam on both sides of the line.
- 7. Cut along the drawn line and separate into (2) parts.
- 8. Open and press toward the small triangles. Repeat steps 5-8 with all remaining FG pieces.
- 9. Trim all FG units to 2 ½" x 1 ½".




PIECING INSTRUCTIONS


1. Sew (2) FGs RST to the left and right side of **A** to make (1) 4 ½" x 2 ½" unit. Press seams toward **A**.



2. Sew (2) **B** RST to the left and right side of each remaining FG. Make (2) 4 ½" x 1 ½" units. Press seams toward all **B**.




3. Sew the (2) units from step 2 RST to the top and bottom of the unit made in step 1 to complete (1) 4 ½" x 4 ½" sawtooth star block.




COURTHOUSE STEPS

Press all new seams away from the sawtooth star block.

1. Sew (2) **C** RST to the left and right side of the sawtooth star block, then sew (2) **D** RST to the top and bottom of the unit to make (1) 7 ½" x 7 ½" unit.




2. Sew (2) **E** RST to the left and right side of the unit, then sew (2) **F** RST to the top and bottom of the unit to make (1) 10 ½" x 10 ½" unit.





COURTHOUSE STEPS

3. Sew (2) **G** RST to the left and right side of the unit, then sew (2) **H** RST to the top and bottom of the unit to make (1) 13 ½" x 13 ½" unit.



4. Sew (2) I RST to the left and right side of the unit, then sew (2) J RST to the top and bottom of the unit to complete the 16 ½" x 16 ½" block. Reserve the block for quilt assembly instructions.
