

Hi There.

This block is doing double duty because we're making Quarter-Square Triangles and placing the design on point! QSTs are made by combining two Half-Square Triangles and just like HSTs, trimming is key to keeping everything clean and lined up. Setting a block on point means we're rotating it so it looks like a diamond. It's a beautiful way to highlight a design element, but it also means we're working with more bias edges, so go ahead and starch your fabric ahead of time to help minimize stretching.



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



Half - Square Triangles


Gather all **HST 1** squares from Fabric **1**, **2**, **3**, and **4** and pair them each with (1) **Fabric 5 HST 2** square. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the lighter square from each pairing and use the instructions below to make 2-at-a-time HSTs.



HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Place (1) pair of corresponding HST squares RST.
- 2. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the diagonal line.
- 3. Cut along the line and separate the unit into (2) parts.
- 4. Open and press seams toward the darker fabric.
- 5. Trim all HSTs to 5 1/4" x 5 1/4".
- 6. Repeat steps 1-5 to make:




NOTE: Keep (1) HST from each pairing for piecing instructions, and save the other for another project.



Quarter - Square Triangles

Gather all (4) 5 ½" x 5 ½" **Fabric 5 QST** squares and pair them up with each of the (4) HSTs. Use the instructions below to make quarter-square triangles.

QUARTER-SQUARE TRIANGLE INSTRUCTIONS





- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the **Fabric 5** square and place it RST with a HST so that the diagonal line runs perpendicular to the diagonal seam of the HST.
- 2. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the diagonal line.
- 3. Cut along the line and separate the unit into (2) parts.
- 4. Open and press towards the darker fabric triangle.
- 5. Trim the new QSTs to 4 ³/₄" x 4 ³/₄" QSTs and repeat steps 1-5 with the remaining (3) HSTs and (3) **QST** squares to make a total of (8) QSTs:



NOTE: Keep (1) QST from each pairing for piecing instructions, and save the other for another project.

Piecing Preparation: Cut (1) **A** square in half diagonally twice to divide it into (4) **A** triangles. Then, cut the (2) **B** squares in half diagonally once each to make a total of (4) **B** triangles.









PIECING INSTRUCTIONS


1. Place (1) **B** triangle RST to the top of (1) **Fabric 1 QST** so that the corners of the triangle piece will extend evenly past the QST edges by about ½". Sew a ½" seam along the edge and press the triangle piece open. Repeat this step with all remaining **B** triangles and QSTs.




2. Place (1) A triangle RST to the right side of the Fabric 2 Unit made in step 1, making sure to align the bottom edges. The top corner of the triangle will extend past the Fabric 2 Unit by about 1/4". Sew a 1/4" seam along the edge and press the triangle piece open.




3. Place (1) A triangle RST to the left side of the unit from step 2, making sure to align the bottom edges. The top corner of the triangle will extend past the Fabric 2 Unit by about 1/4". Sew a 1/4" seam along the edge and press the triangle piece open.



 Repeat steps 2 and 3 using the remaining (2) A triangles and the Fabric 4 Unit.




5. From left to right, sew RST into a row: **Fabric 3 Unit**, **C**, and **Fabric 1 Unit**. Press seams toward the **C** square.




PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

6. Sew the **Fabric 2 Unit** from step 3 RST to the left side of the unit made in step 5. Then, sew the **Fabric 4 Unit** from step 4 RST to the right side of the unit. Trim off dog ears and square up to 14 ½" x 14 ½".



7. Gather the following pieces and sew them RST into rows to make (1) 16 ½" x 2 ½" Long Strip Set A and (1) 16 ½" x 2 ½" Long Strip Set B.




8. Gather the following pieces and sew them RST into rows to make (1) 12 ½" x 2 ½" Short Strip Set A and (1) 12 ½" x 2 ½" Short Strip Set B.




PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

9. With careful consideration of fabric placement, sew **Short Strip Set B** RST to the left side of the unit made in step 6, then sew **Short Strip Set A** RST to the right side of the unit to make (1) 16 ½" x 12 ½" unit.



10. With careful consideration of fabric placement, sew **Long Strip Set A** RST to the top of the unit made in step 9, then sew **Long Strip Set B** RST to the bottom of the unit to complete the 16 ½" x 16 ½" block. Reserve the block for quilt assembly instructions.
