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




GEOMETRIC WOODEN NECKLACE BY ASHLEY ROSE



- DREMEL TOOL
- PAINT
- PAINT BRUSHES
- 3 1/2 WOODEN TRIANGLE
- GOLD CHAIN NECKLACE (OR CHAIN AND CLASP)
- ROUND-NOSE JEWELRY PLIERS
- GOLD JUMP RINGS
- PAINTERS TAPE



1. Using a dremel, drill small holes in two corners of the wooden triangle just big enough to comfortably fit the jump rings.



2. Use painters tape to tape off random sections of your triangle to paint, or free-hand it if you're feeling wild! Then let it dry completely.



3. Insert a jump ring through one corner of the triangle. Attach a loop from your necklace chain and then secure the jump ring using the round-nose pliers. Repeat this step for the opposite side.



4. Your necklace is ready to make a statement!
